## LOT 23: GR Home Run Bull

Reg # 44333037 DOB 4-25-21 BW 72 WW 591 YW 995. Dam is a moderate framed 8 year old cow, perfect udder and feet. I would expect great growth from his calves, and another great heifer bull.

**LOT 24:** *York Bull* Commercial bull DOB 5-29-21 BW 77 WW 581 YW 912. Dam is an 8 year old proven cow, always one of the first to breed back, raises nice heavy calves. He should produce great growth and nice marked calves.

#### **OUR FOCUS:**

Calving ease, good maternal instinct. Growth based on a forage based diet, calves are creep fed grass only as a means of bunk breaking, shelter in a confined space, and human interaction. Temperament is very important. Any animal that displaying poor temperament characteristics is culled. Cows are expected to breed back in 45 days, calve unassisted, and raise a nice calf every year, otherwise will be culled. Healthy animals, good feet, productive females, eye pigment and longevity will help to increase your bottom line. Herd developed using Rausch Hereford genetics. Hereford Bulls on black cows utilize hybrid vigor making great baldies.

#### ANIMALS:

Bulls and heifers are forage raised on pasture and alfalfa. They are bunk broke to hay, cake for the last 30 to 45 days. They are walked through daily for health and temperament.

#### **SELLING:**

Twenty-four Hereford Bulls age 15 to 22 months - 15 registered, 11 commercial. Two 4 year old proven herd sires - 1 red, 1 black. Seven commercial Hereford heifers. Lot 3 through 8 are bulls purchased from Rausch Herefords in Hoven South Dakota.

#### **VACCINATIONS:**

All animals UTD on vaccinations, due again Fall 2023

#### **BREEDING SEASON GUARANTEE:**

All Bulls come with first breeding season guarantee. Although the Bulls are breeding soundness tested, we recommend testing any bull prior to turnout for breeding. Bulls failing to breed must be verified by a veterinarian. Arrangements will be made to pick up the bull, they will tested on cows for up to 5 months, and arrangements will be made to satisfy the customer.
